

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANTS GOVERNANCE FOR SOCIAL IMPACT MELBOURNE 13-14 SEPETMEBER 2023

GRANT CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

There are 2 grants available for the program to be held on 13-14 September in Melbourne.

The grants are available to non-executive board directors from registered not-for-profits across Australia to undertake the Governance for Social Impact 2-day Program, delivered in partnership between AGSM and CSI UNSW.

These grants will cover the full cost of the course fee.

Grants are awarded based on merit. Each applicant will be assessed on their demonstrated leadership and engagement in supporting, developing, and contributing to better outcomes in the social purpose sector. Applicants are encouraged to outline their ability to apply and scale program learnings after completion of the program.

- Applications close: 11:59pm Friday 21 July 2023
- Successful candidates notified: Friday 4 August 2023

Please note, late applications cannot be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- You are an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia.
- You currently hold a position as a non-executive director on the Board of a not-for-profit organisation (NFP) or ACNC registered charity.
- You have this or an equivalent position as a non-executive director on a Board for a minimum of 12 months.

SELECTION CRITERIA

To apply, applicants are required to email the following information to Karin Waldmann, Executive Education Program Manager (lisa.casey1@unsw.edu.au) by the due date.

- 1. Your biography (max 200 words) and a headshot
- 2. A letter/email of support from an NFP leader (for example a fellow board member or an executive from the NFP you work with)
- 3. A 1–2-page submission answering the following questions (max 200 words per question):
 - What is it about this program specifically that is of interest for you and why is this the right time for you to engage in a governance leadership program?



- Please outline how you have demonstrated your commitment to the social sector and bringing about long term positive social change.
- o How will your organisation benefit from your participation in this program?
- How do you intend to scale program learnings and create impact from the knowledge gained at this program?

If you are successful as grant recipient, we will request your feedback to our grant donor. Questions may be along the lines of your experience and the impact of the grant in relation to your governance role, and how you will utilise the learning outcomes in the future.
