THE AUSTRALIAN HOMELESSNESS ATLAS

The Australian Homelessness Atlas is based on estimates of homelessness by Local Government Area in the 2021 Census (Australian Bureau of Statistics 2021).

The 2021 Census was undertaken at a time when COVID-19 lockdown provisions had significant impacts on enumeration outcomes in certain areas. In particular, enumeration of people sleeping rough was not undertaken in the Greater Sydney area with reliance on administrative data from the NSW Department of Communities. Enumeration of people sleeping rough was delayed in metropolitan Melbourne and restricted. As a result, the Census may have underestimated the number of people enumerated as sleeping rough in Greater Sydney and, to a lesser extent, Melbourne. In both Sydney and Melbourne the number of people enumerated as living in ‘other temporary lodgings’ was affected by the number of rough sleepers given temporary accommodation due to COVID-19 support provisions. Improved administrative records in NSW and Victoria of those in temporary lodgings may also have increased the count in this operational group.

The ABS uses six homeless operational groups:

- people living in improvised dwellings, tents or sleeping out (rough sleeping)
- people in supported accommodation for the homeless
- people staying temporarily with other households
- people living in boarding houses
- people in other temporary lodgings
- people living in ‘severely’ crowded dwellings.

In this Atlas we present estimates of the number of people who are enumerated as rough sleeping and experiencing homelessness across all homeless operational categories and the rate of rough sleeping and homelessness (persons per 10,000).


