



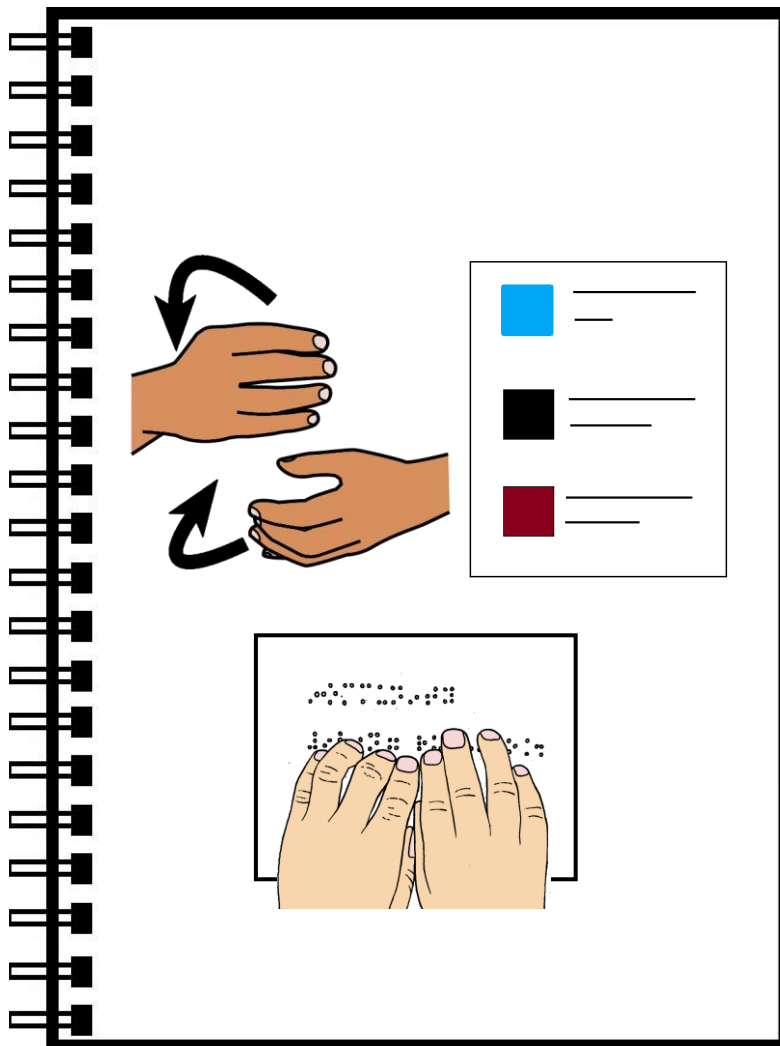

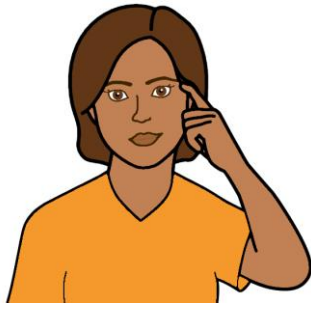

Like you may be blind.

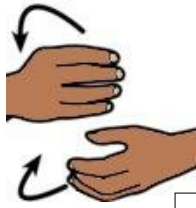
You can **not** see words on a page.

You can **not** read papers.



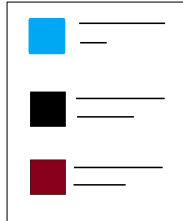
You need information in a different way.

- in large print.

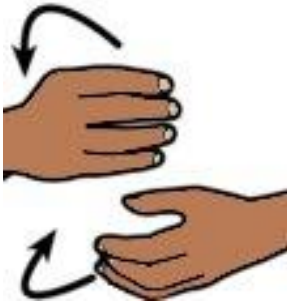

You can get information in the way you need.



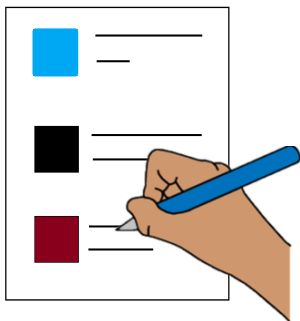
## Groups who make information



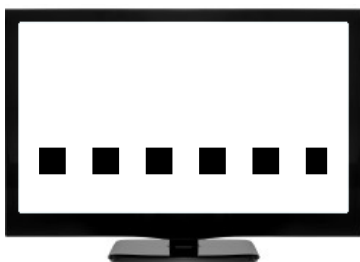
There are groups who make information.

Some groups write papers in Easy English.

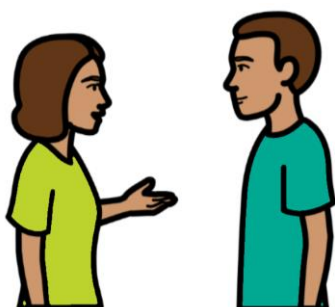


Some groups put words on the screen.



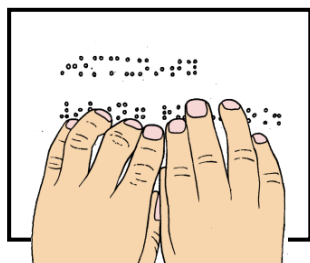
Services have information for you.

Like the fire service have a bush fire plan.



They need to make the plan easy to use.

They ask these groups to help them.



Like you may need the plan in Braille.

The fire service asks a group to write the Braille.



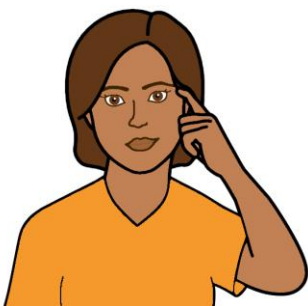
The fire service pays the group.



**Some problems**



There may be danger. Like a flood.



You need to know what to do.

It is to stay safe.



Like you get ready for floods.

You pack a bag.

You need to know what to pack.

**And**



Your house may flood.

You are stuck. You can **not** leave.

You need to know what to do.



There is a flood plan.

It helps you know what to do.

**But**



The plan may be

- hard to read
- hard to use.



Like the plan is on a website.

It may **not** work for screen readers.

Your screen reader can **not** read the plan.

Or



You need the plan in a different way. Like

- so you can listen to it

or

- in Easy Read.





We talked to groups who make information.

They made information about the

- floods
- bush fires
- COVID 19.



They said it was hard.

The government did **not** plan for what you need.



The groups needed

- more money
- more help
- more staff to do the work.



You did **not** get the information you need.

You did **not** know what to do.

Or



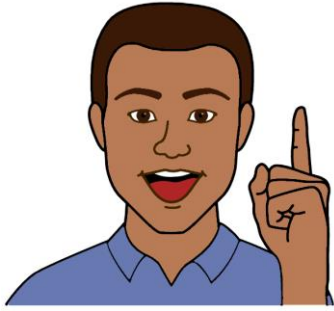
You had to wait a long long time.

Like 1 month.

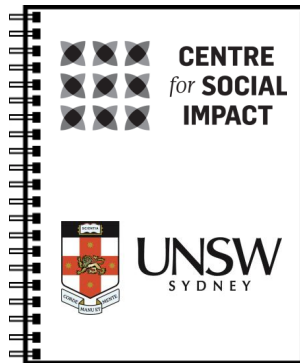

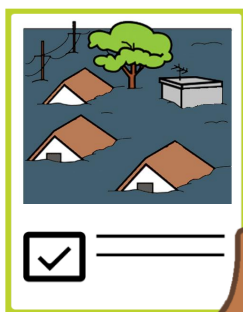
## Our ideas for change

We are from the Centre for Social Impact.

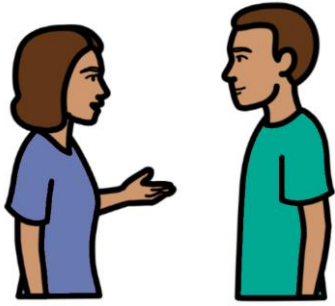

These are our ideas for change.

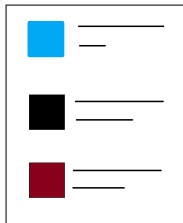
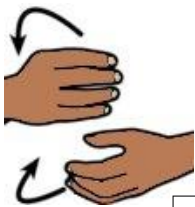


We will tell people about our ideas. Like

- the government.

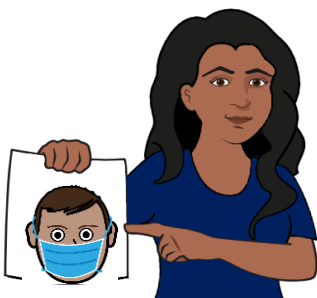


**We need new laws**



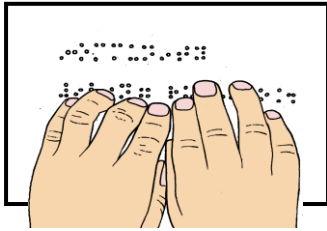
The new laws **must** tell services to make information easy to use. Like

Like they write a paper in Braille.

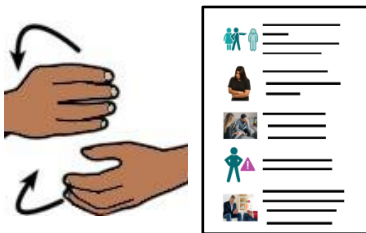


They ask a person who uses Braille to

- check it.



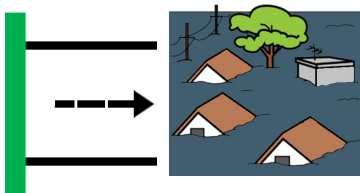
Groups need more money

**Easy English. Easy Read.**

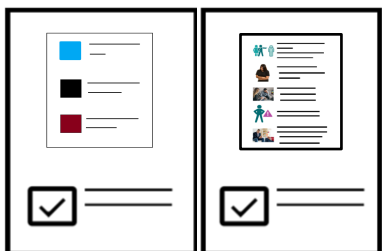
Some groups write Easy English

They need pictures of things you know. Like

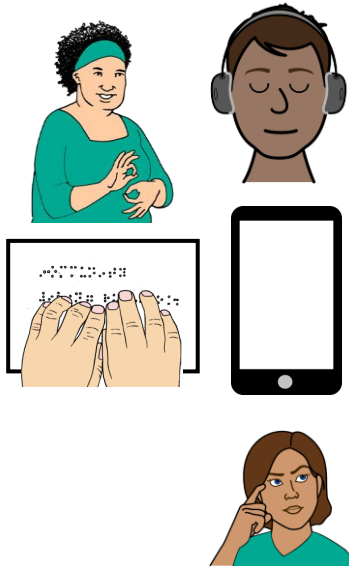
- trees you see in Australia
